11. I understand that the registration charge and all insurance premiums are non-refundable, unless the permit is returned prior to the effective date shown on the permit.
12. I declare, to the best of my knowledge, that the vehicle specified in this application does not create a hazard to other people or property if operated on a roadway for the purpose stated in this application.

Motorcycles

The following declarations only appear on a temporary registration application for a motorcycle:

- I understand that the motorcycle coverage provided by this certificate is limited to collision and upset only.
- I understand that the motorcycle coverage provided by this certificate is limited to 15 days of general use per calendar year (consecutive or cumulative days), and after 15 days, must be used for specific purposes only.

Trucks

The following declarations only appear on a temporary registration application for a truck:

- I understand that vehicles with a GVW greater than 16,300 kg have no physical damage coverage.
- I understand the Periodic Mandatory Inspection (PMVI) requirements to which my vehicle may be subject, and to adhere to these requirements if applicable.

Semi Trailers:

Semi-trailers have only registration and do not have physical damage coverage or third-party liability.

Temporary Registration FAQ

How many permits can I have?

- If the vehicle has a valid safety, or has previously been registered in your name, you can purchase up to three (3) temporary registration permits per vehicle, totaling a maximum of thirty (30) days every 12 months.
- If the vehicle does not have a valid safety, and you have never had it registered, you can purchase one (1) temporary registration permit per vehicle, up to a maximum of seven (7) days every 12 months.
- Motorcycles are eligible for up to 15 days of temporary registration per calendar year. This includes one registration for 15 consecutive days or multiple registrations for a total period of 15 days cumulative.

What documents are typically required?

If it was previously registered in your name, or if you paid \$15 for ownership:

- No documents are required

If you have not set up ownership of the vehicle in the MPI system:

- Proof of purchase (i.e., bill of sale, exclusive use agreement, letter of gift, etc.)
- Transfer ownership document (not required, but recommended)

* *This is not a complete list of required documents. Additional or alternative documents may be required on a case-by-case basis. Call our office for clarification.*

How do I display the temporary registration certificate and plate?

Certificate:

1. Fold the temporary registration certificate in half, along the vertical dotted line that is marked FOLD HERE FIRST. Next, fold along the horizontal dotted line marked FOLD HERE SECOND.
 - * Folding in this manner will ensure that the personal information is protected from view both inside and outside the vehicle.
2. The temporary registration certificate must be attached to the inside of the vehicle windshield, in the lower right-hand corner (passenger side), so that the expiry date and validation stamp are visible from the outside of the vehicle.

Plate:

1. Affix the plate to the rear of the vehicle using the existing licence plate bolts. Advise the customer that other plates (including in the front of the vehicle) must be either removed or covered.

What is the cost of a permit?

Semi-Trailers \$9

Passenger Vehicles, Trucks & Motorcycles: prices start at \$38

Does DOT have any requirements for vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) 4,500 kg or more?

Yes, a vehicle with a GVWR of 4,500 kg or more that does not have a valid safety inspection will require a specialty Transport Permit. The Transport Permit requires a separate application, it is only valid for 24 hours and will allow the vehicle to be taken to an inspection station or place for repairs.
